



# VASESHIPPING (ATEM x MANA) PAPER DOLL

### **Introduction:**

In the Millennium World saga of the "Yu-Gi-Oh!" anime, there was a particular scene where Mana jumps out of a vase and hugs Atem. A handful of viewers who saw this scene, myself included, immediately came to the idea that Atem and Mana make a rather cute pairing.

As the pairing is not considered canon, many create fan art of this pairing. While I like traditional fan art, I feel that paper dolls provide a greater creative space. In fact, I encourage you to go beyond what I have done and design your own clothes for the doll! I hope you enjoy this work as much as I had enjoyed creating it.

### **Brief Notes:**

- Cut along **lines colored orange**.
- The **light green tabs** on the shoe pieces are not for anchoring. They are intended to be glued to a designated backpiece in order to form a pocket that the feet can slide into.

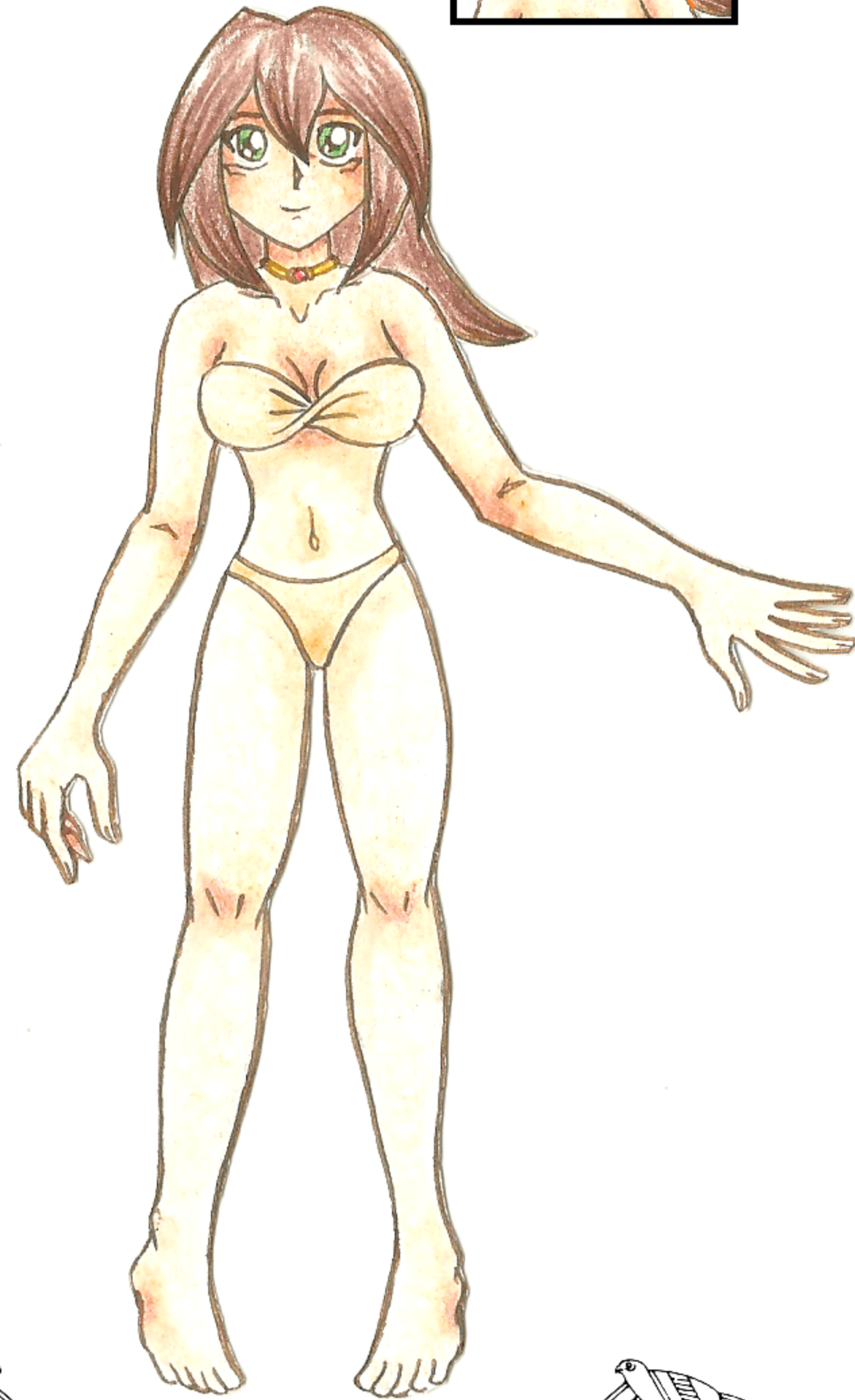
### **Tips:**

- Some craft and office stores sell specialty synthetic paper that are tear-proof. These are a great option that can help extend the life of the paper doll. If using this kind of paper, please be sure to pick one that is easily foldable and not crease-proof.
- See if you can get magnetic sheets. Printing on magnetic sheets eliminates the need to have tabs!
- If you plan on making your own clothes and wish to match my method of coloring, my medium of choice was brown walnut ink (applied using a crowquill dip pen) and colored pencil.




Note: Cut extra slits along orange lines (see diagram below)




Mana is a magician serving in the court of Pharaoh Atemu. She eventually becomes the guardian of the Millennium Ring under Pharaoh Seto's reign.



Fold down the **tan tabs** and glue to back of doll to form a pocket with the opening at the bottom. The top of the stand slides into the pocket.

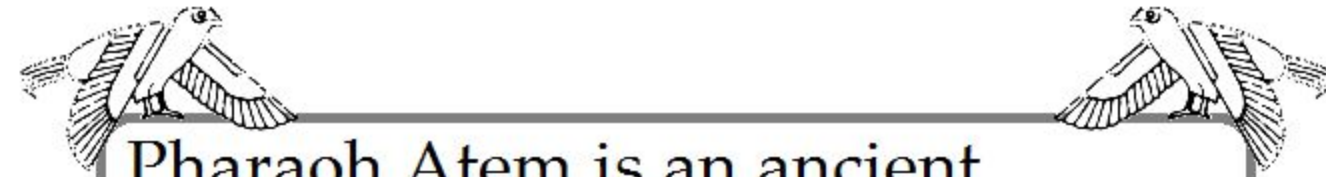
Optional Doll Stand:  
Doll stand contains crude rendering on ancient Egyptian flower motif.



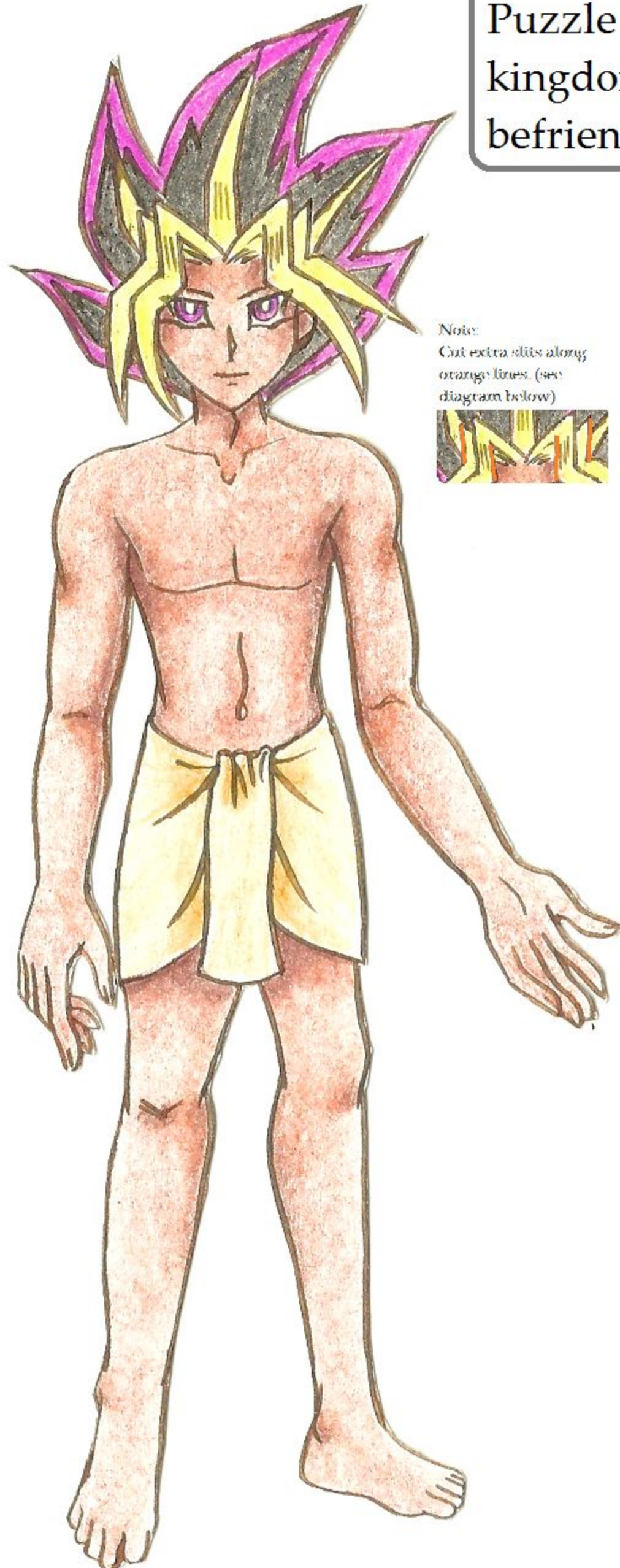
These attach to the backside of the shoes. Make three copies and glue these pieces to the **green tabs** to turn the shoes into a pocket the feet side into.

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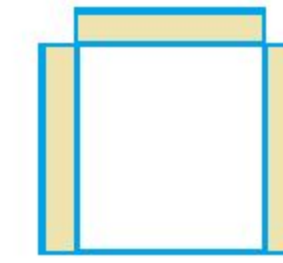
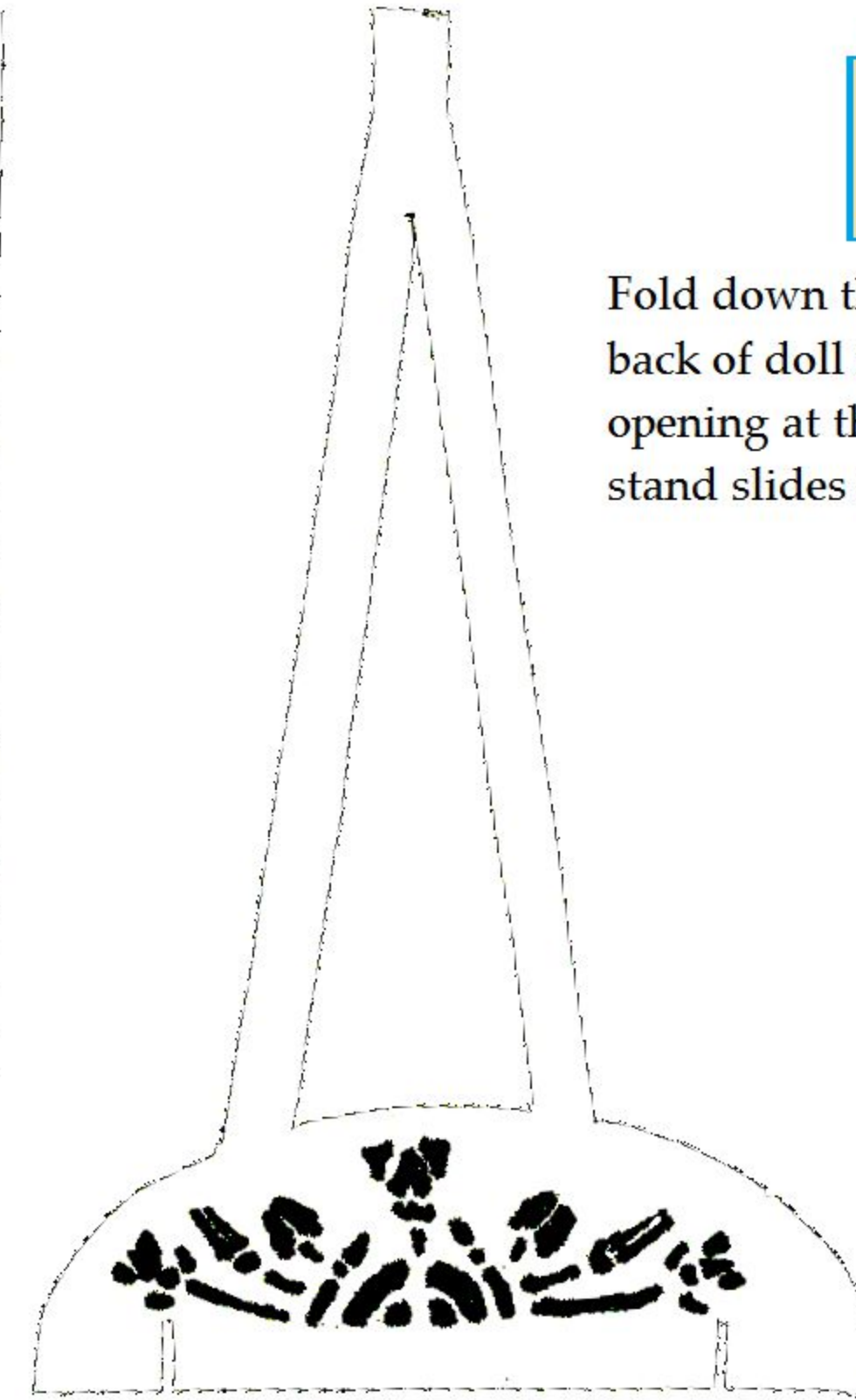

Pharaoh Atem is an ancient Egyptian pharaoh who sealed his spirit away in the Millennium Puzzle in order to save his kingdom. During his childhood, he befriended Mana.

Doll stand contains crude rendering on ancient Egyptian flower motif.



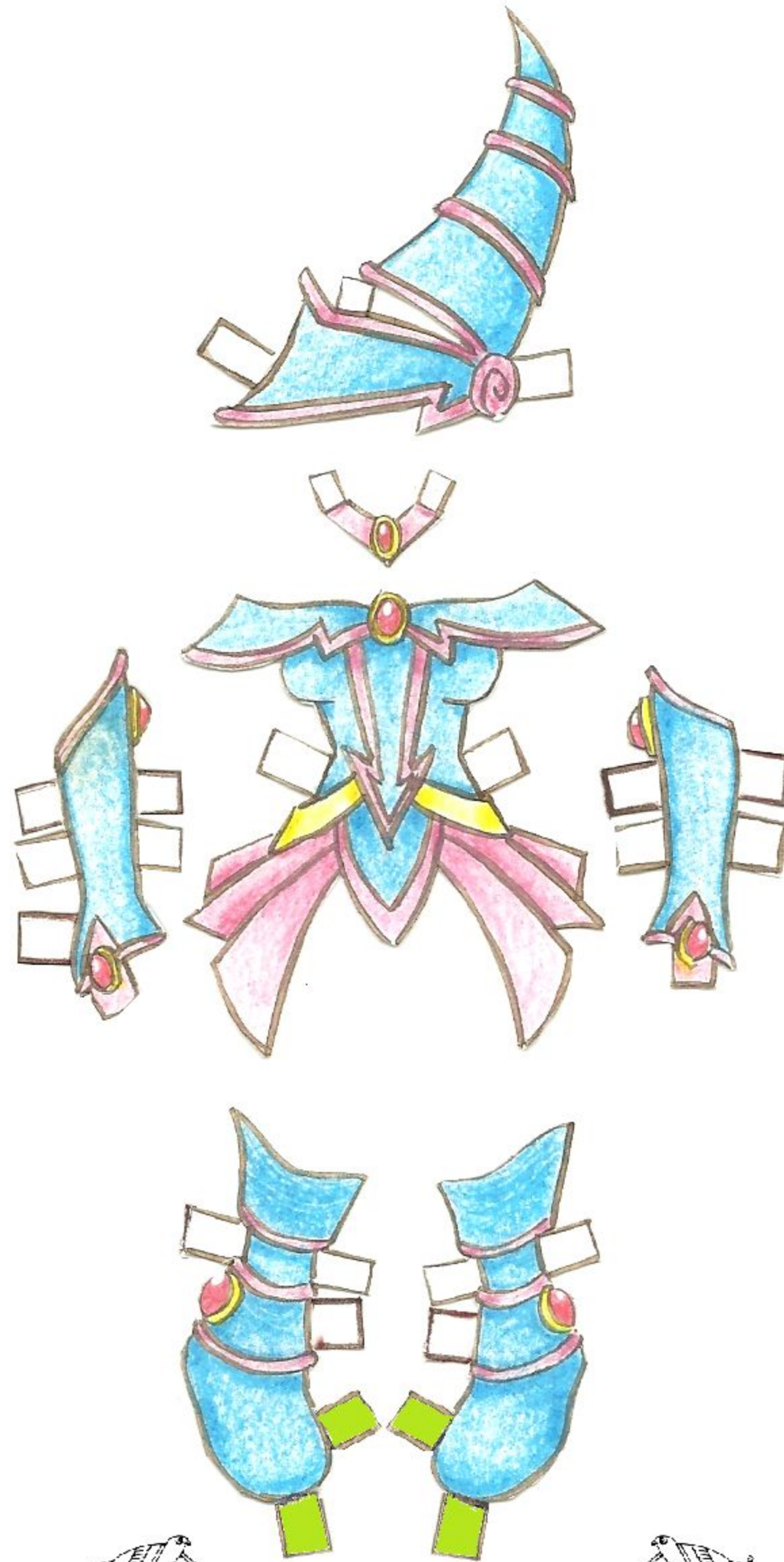
These attach to the backside of the shoes.

**Apprentice Outfit:**

Mana studied magic under the skilled High Priest Mahad. She wore this outfit when she was an apprentice.



**Dark Magician Girl Outfit:**

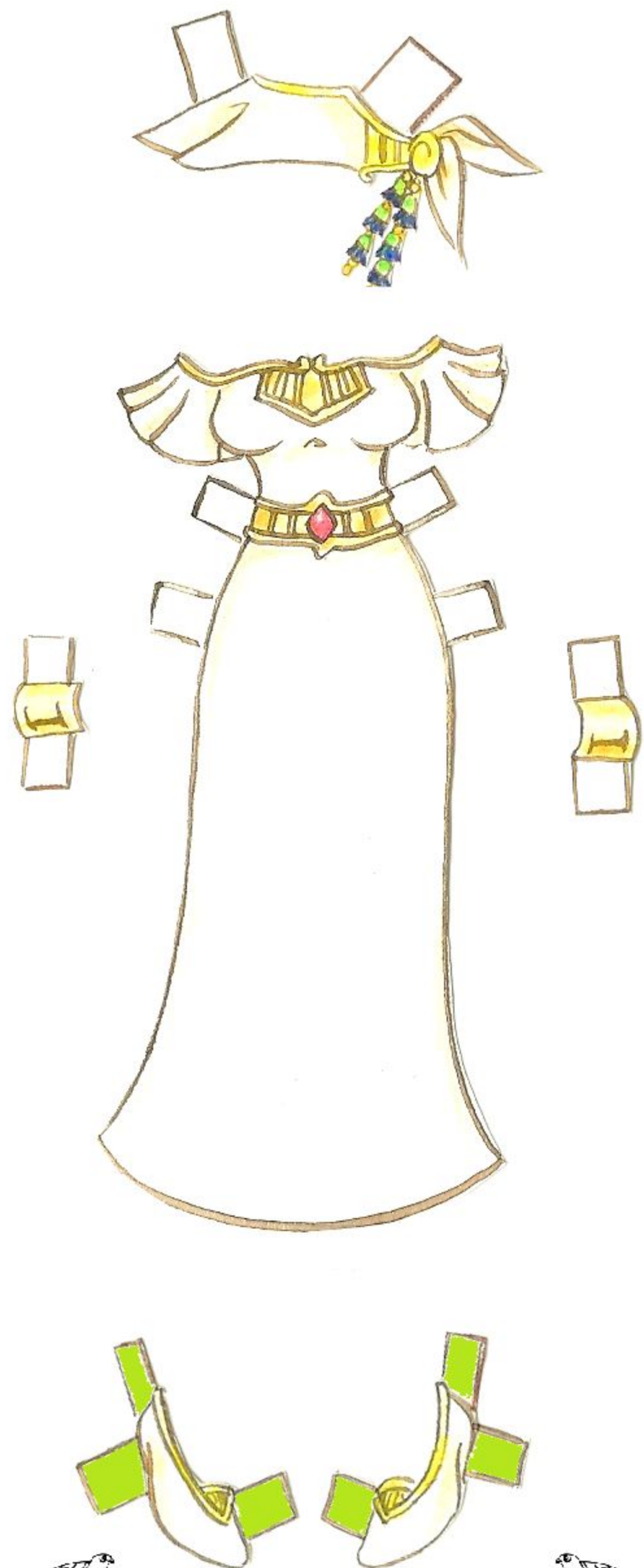
During Atem's fight against Zorc Necrophades, Mana's ka manifested itself in the form of the Dark Magician Girl.



Make sure to keep this hook intact. It helps the headpiece to grab to the head

**Magician's Valkyria Outfit:**

The duel monster Magician's Valkyria is a variant of the Dark Magician Girl design.



**High Priestess Outfit:**

This outfit is what I imagine Mana would be wearing when she got older. It is based off of the apprentice outfit, but features a longer and more slimming skirt.



**Dragon Knight Outfit:**

When fused with Legendary Dragon Timaeus, Dark Magician Girl becomes a sword-wielding knight ready for battle!



**Gather Your Mind Outfit:**

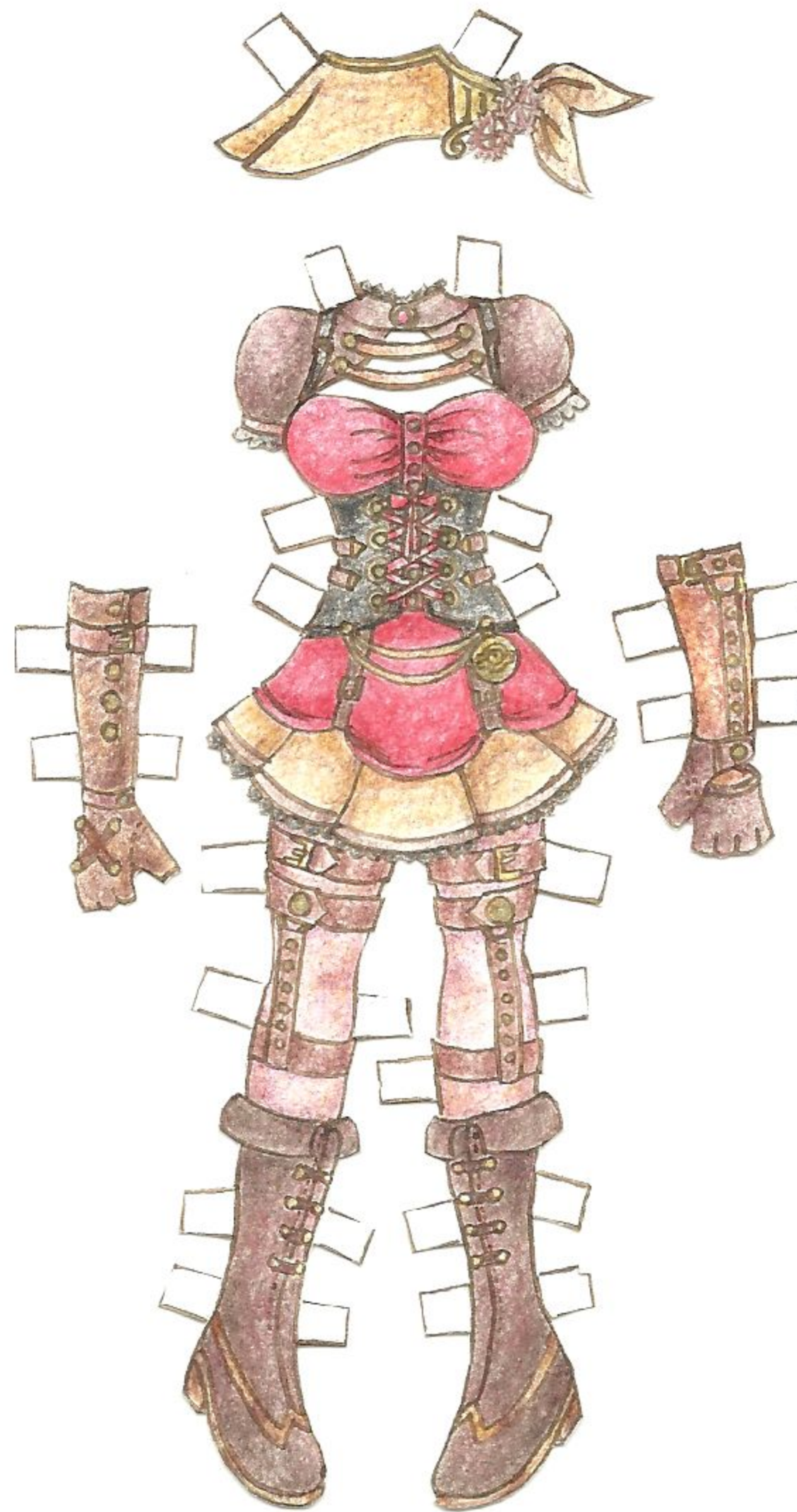
This outfit is based off of the outfit seen in the Duel Monsters trap card "Gather Your Mind".

(cut out eyeholes)



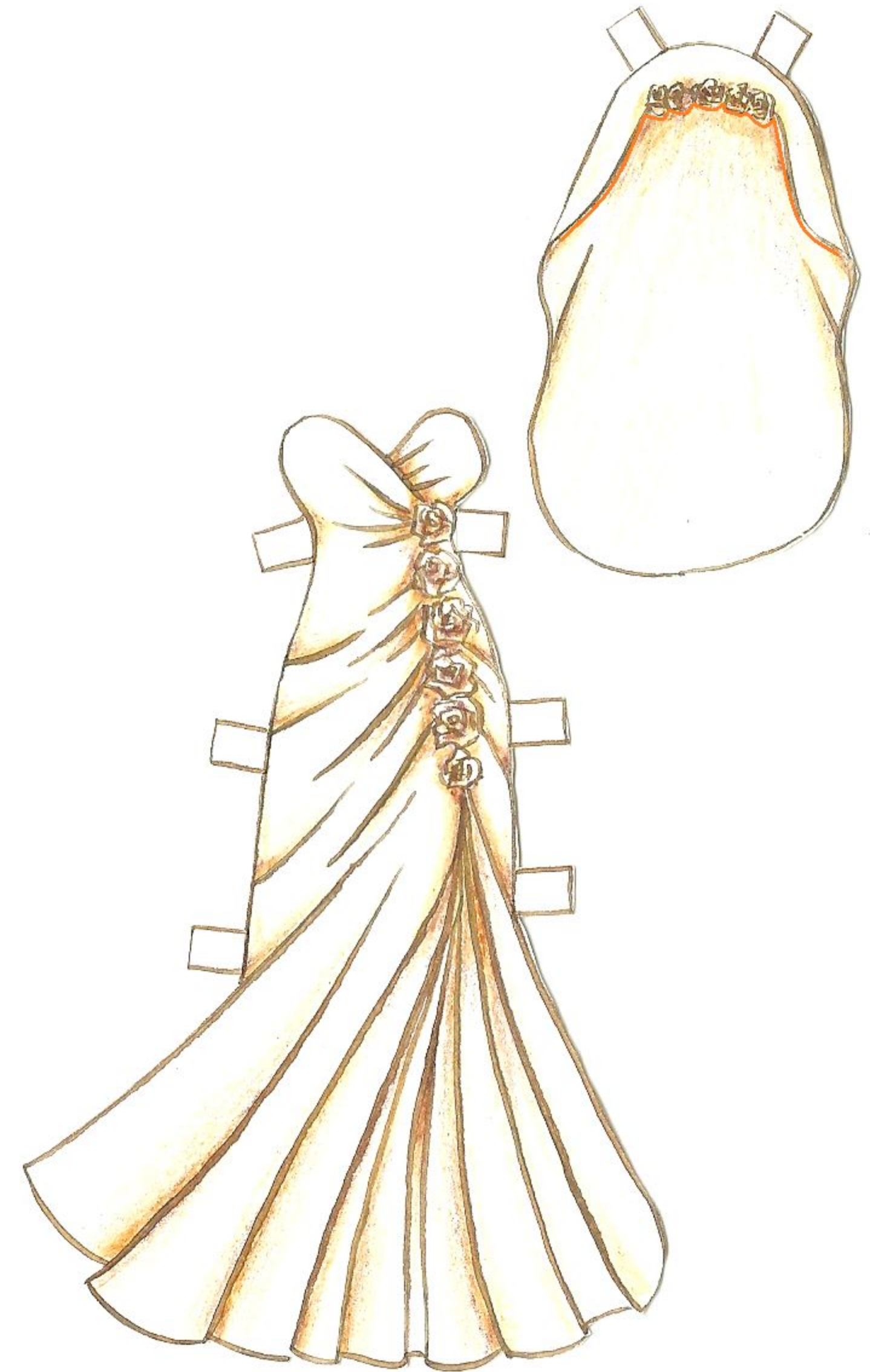
**Japanese Kimono:**

This kimono has a bit of an Egyptian twist, containing images of the blue lotus, an important symbol in ancient Egyptian mythology.



**Steampunk Outfit:**

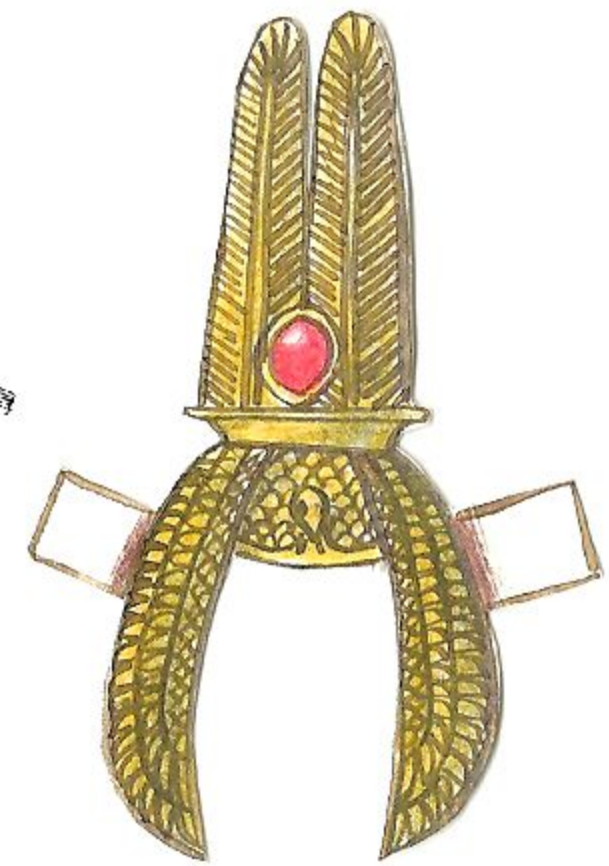
Mana's apprentice outfit is given a spiffy steampunk re-design!



**Wedding Dress:**

A beautiful strapless wedding dress embroidered with roses. (based on design by Suzhou D-Camp Garments Co, Ltd., Model #WD-1077).

**Vulture Cap Crown -** The vulture cap crown, associated with the goddesses Nekhbet and Mut, represented the maternal role of the queen.



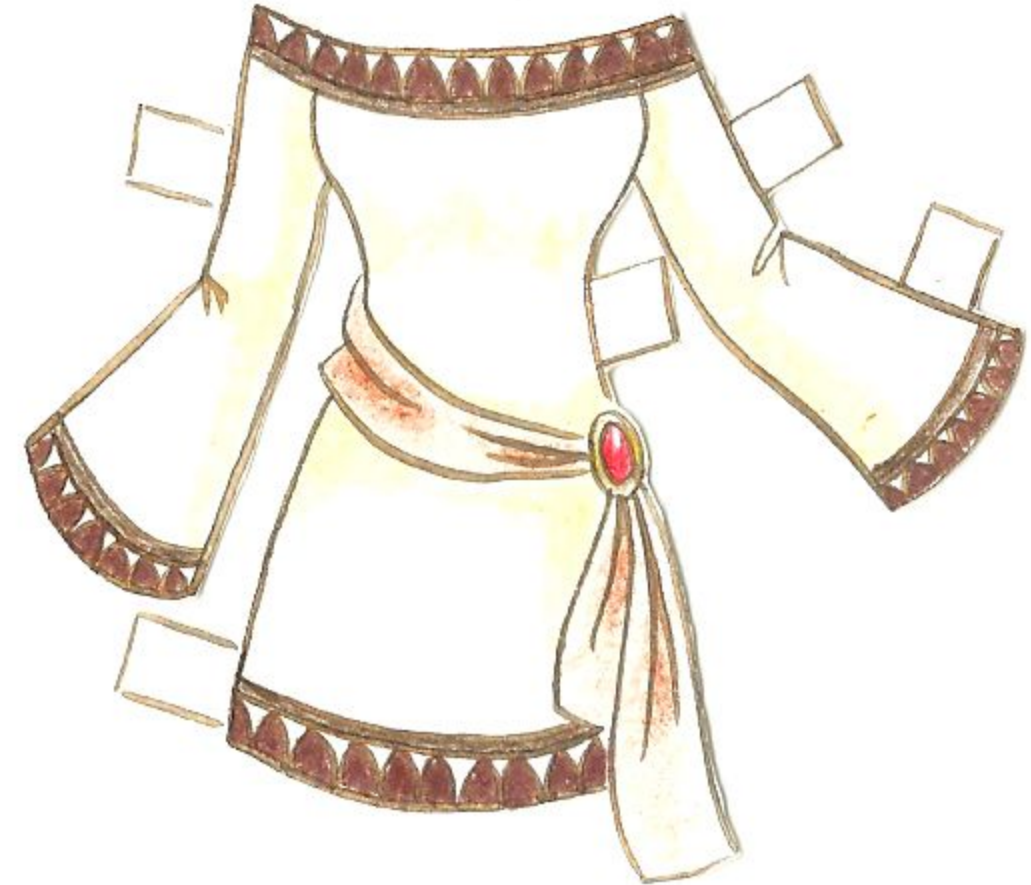
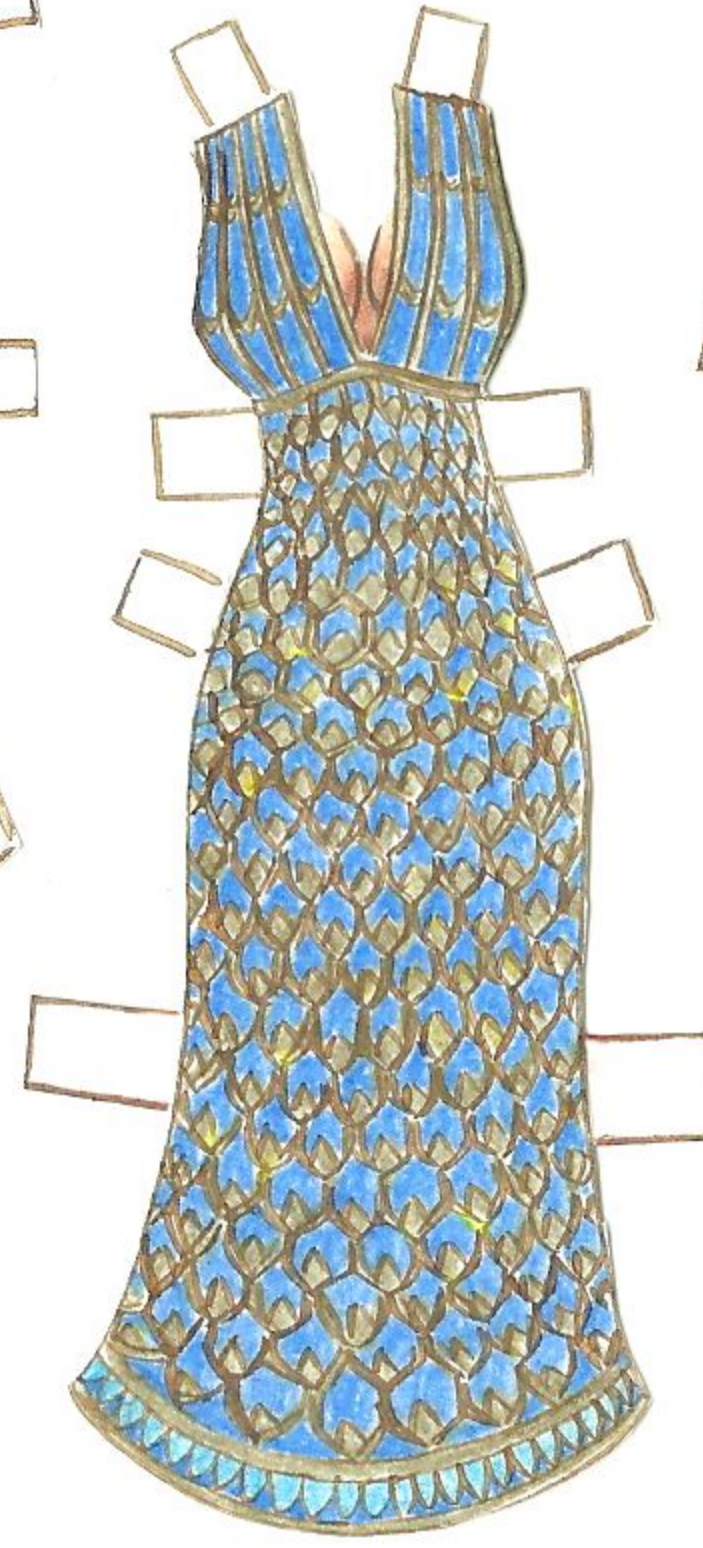
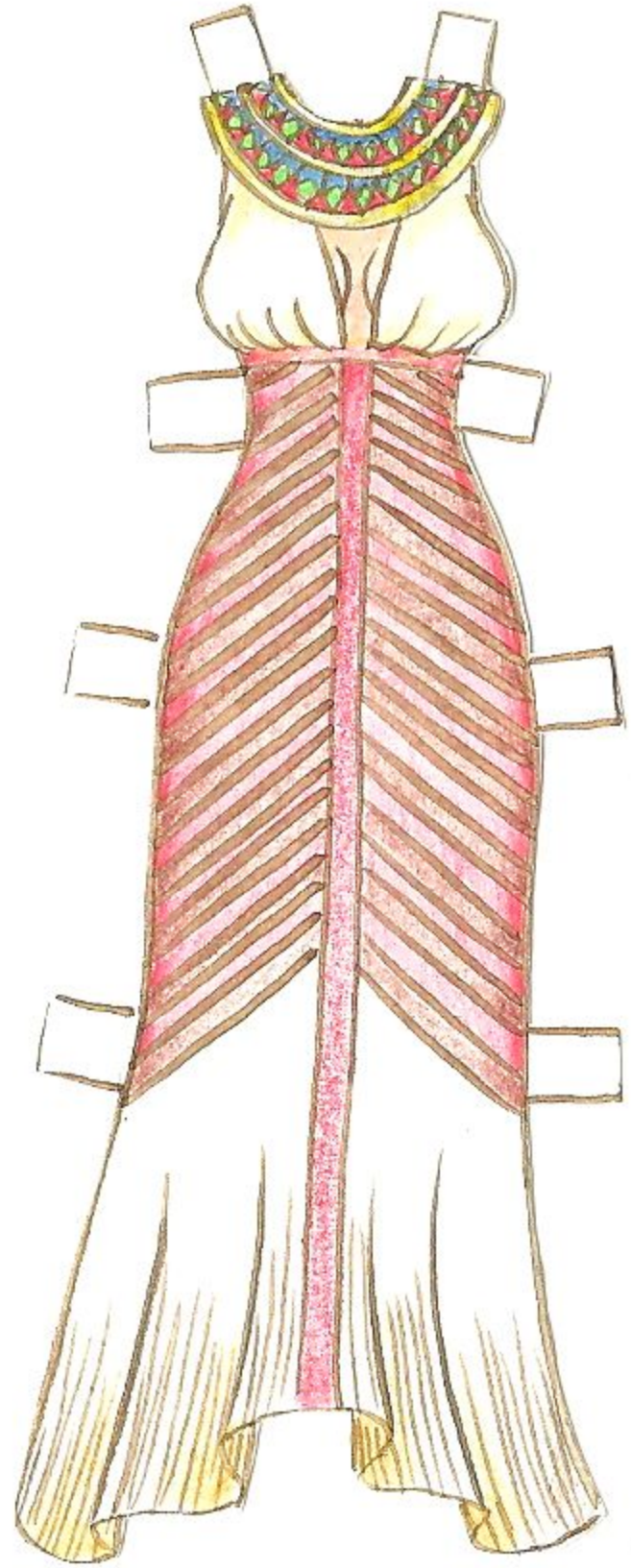
**Double Feather Crown -** The double feathers represent the horizon, the sun disk represents the solar eye.



**Uraeus Crown -** A representation of the goddesses Wadjet and Hathor, containing the sun disk, guarded by cobra, lying inside cow horns.

All hail Queen Mana! The first dress is based on a brace tunic dating back to 1700 BC, the second is a custom kalasiris (Egyptian dress) with a feather pattern.

Custom ancient Egyptian outfits done in style to the manga/anime to the best of my ability.





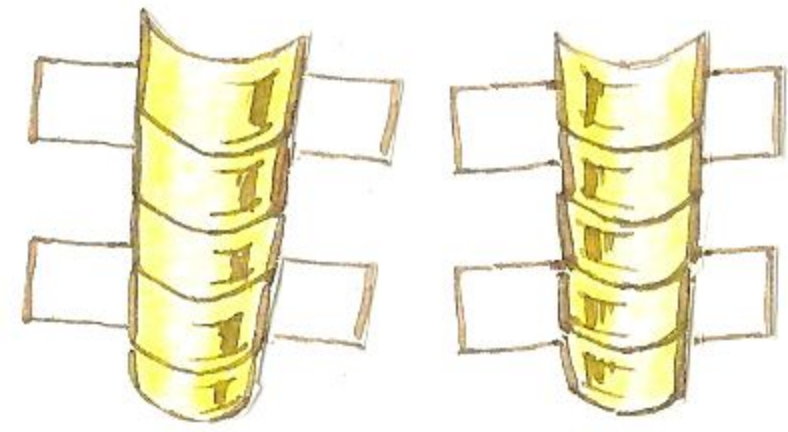
**Formal Wear:**

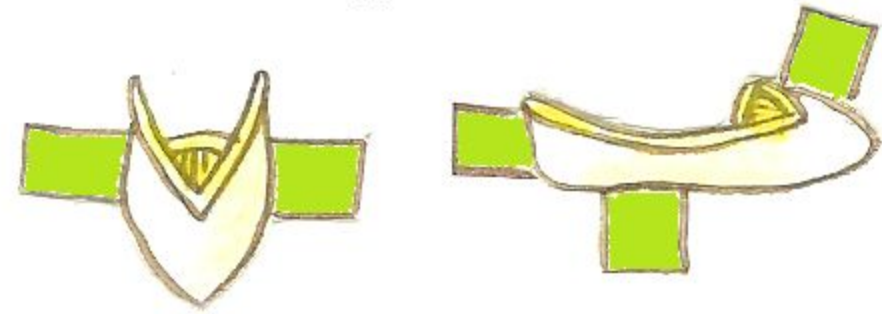


**Fairy Queen Titania:**

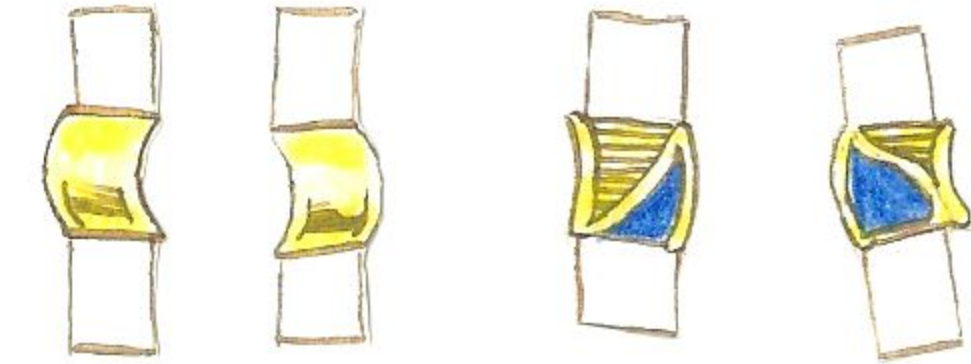

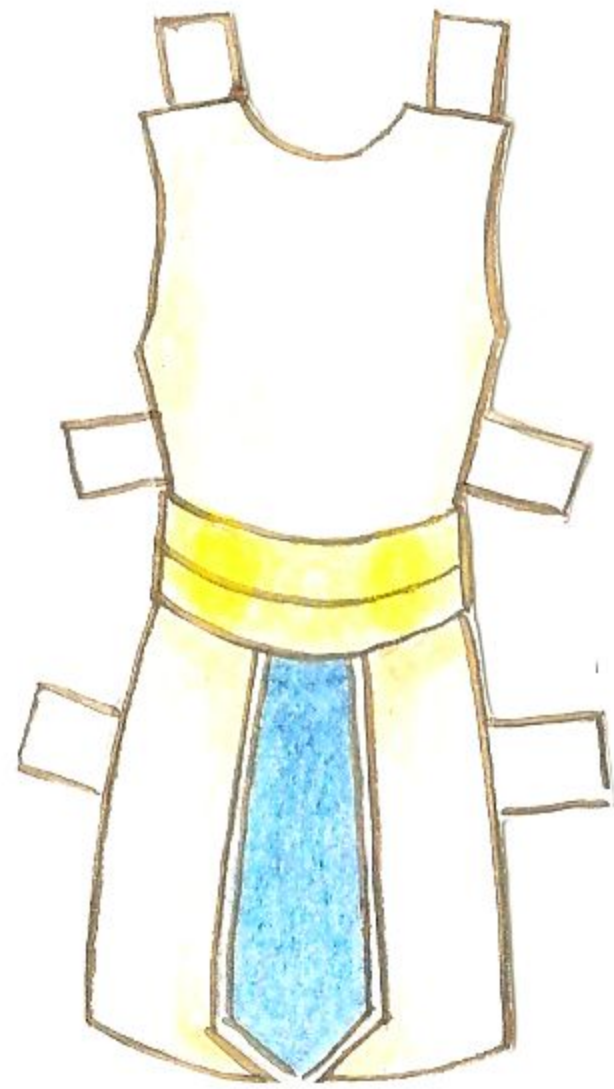

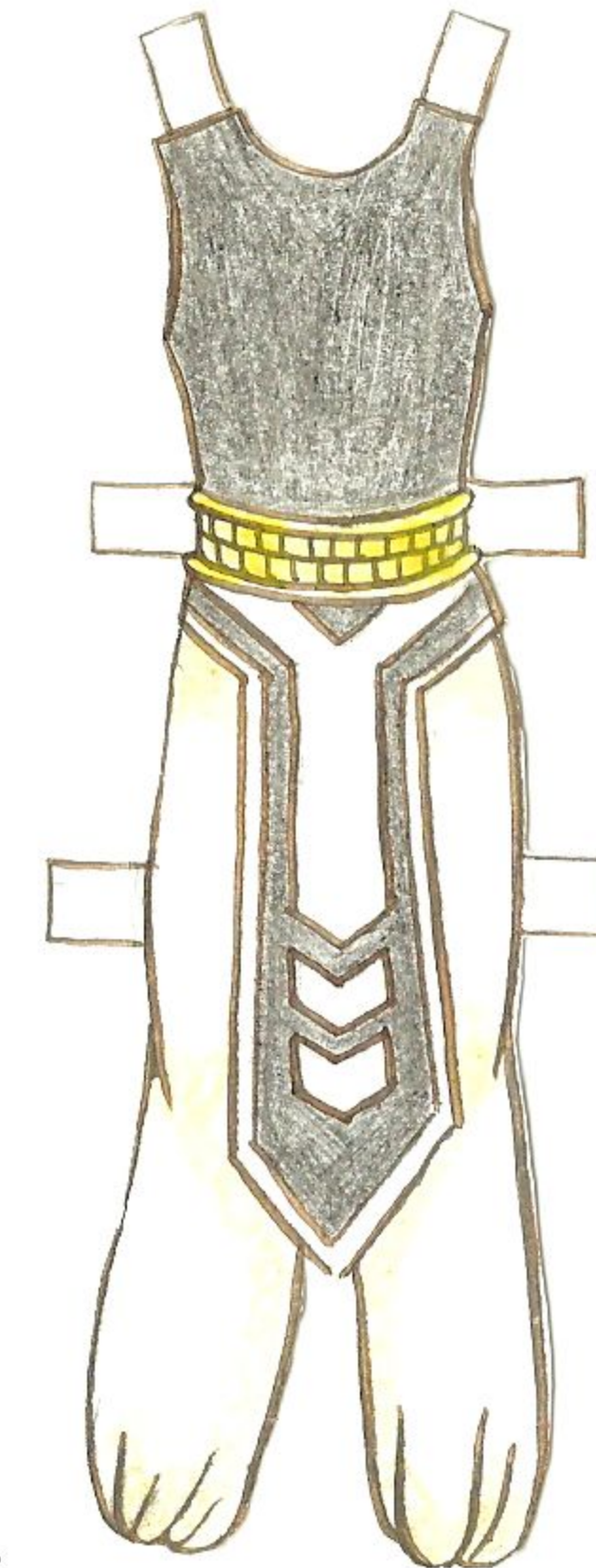
**Millennium World Outfit:**

Atem sports this pharaonic outfit in the Millennium World saga in the "Yu-Gi-Oh!" anime.



**Battle City Flashback Outfit:**

During the Battle City saga of the manga/anime, a lot of flashbacks of the Egyptian past are seen. Atem is seen wearing this outfit in one of the flashbacks.



**Forbidden Memories Outfit:**

The "Yu-Gi-Oh! Forbidden Memories" game is a variant story (with a much happier ending!). Atem wears this outfit during his status as both prince and pharaoh.



Back portion of cape. Goes behind doll, tabs fold forward over shoulders. Use headpiece to hide tabs.

Cut out empty space. Triangular tabs are to be anchored behind neck.



**Sa-Re (Son of Ra) outfit:**  
 'Sa-Re' is an alternate name for pharaoh, who was seen as Ra's descendant. This design is similar to the "Ra's Disciple" card, but uses a more elaborate headpiece.

**Pharaoh Aknamkanon Outfit:**  
 Pharaoh Aknamkanon is Atem's father. His pharaonic outfit and Atem's pharaonic outfit are similar in design, but Aknamkanon's includes a royal robe.

**Amun-Re crown -** Many gods are known to have double feather crowns, this one is based off of the double feather crown of Amun-Re.





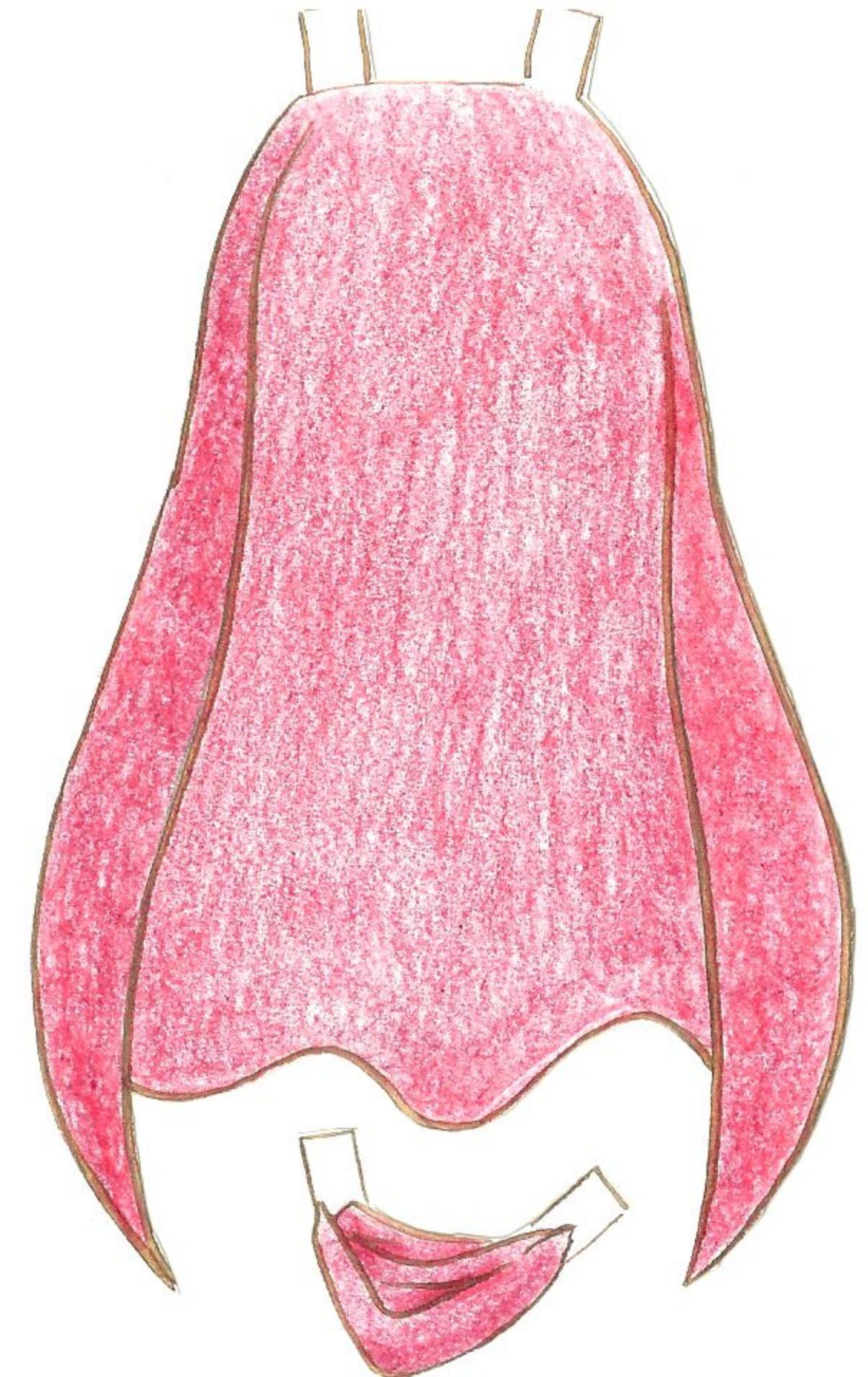
**Legendary Heroes Outfit:**

A brief three-episode story arc features Yugi (Atem's human host) and his pals in a virtual reality role-play game. This outfit is worn by Yugi during that arc.



Front portion of cape

Back portion of cape. Goes behind doll, tabs fold forward over shoulders. Use collar and/or front piece of cape to hide tabs.

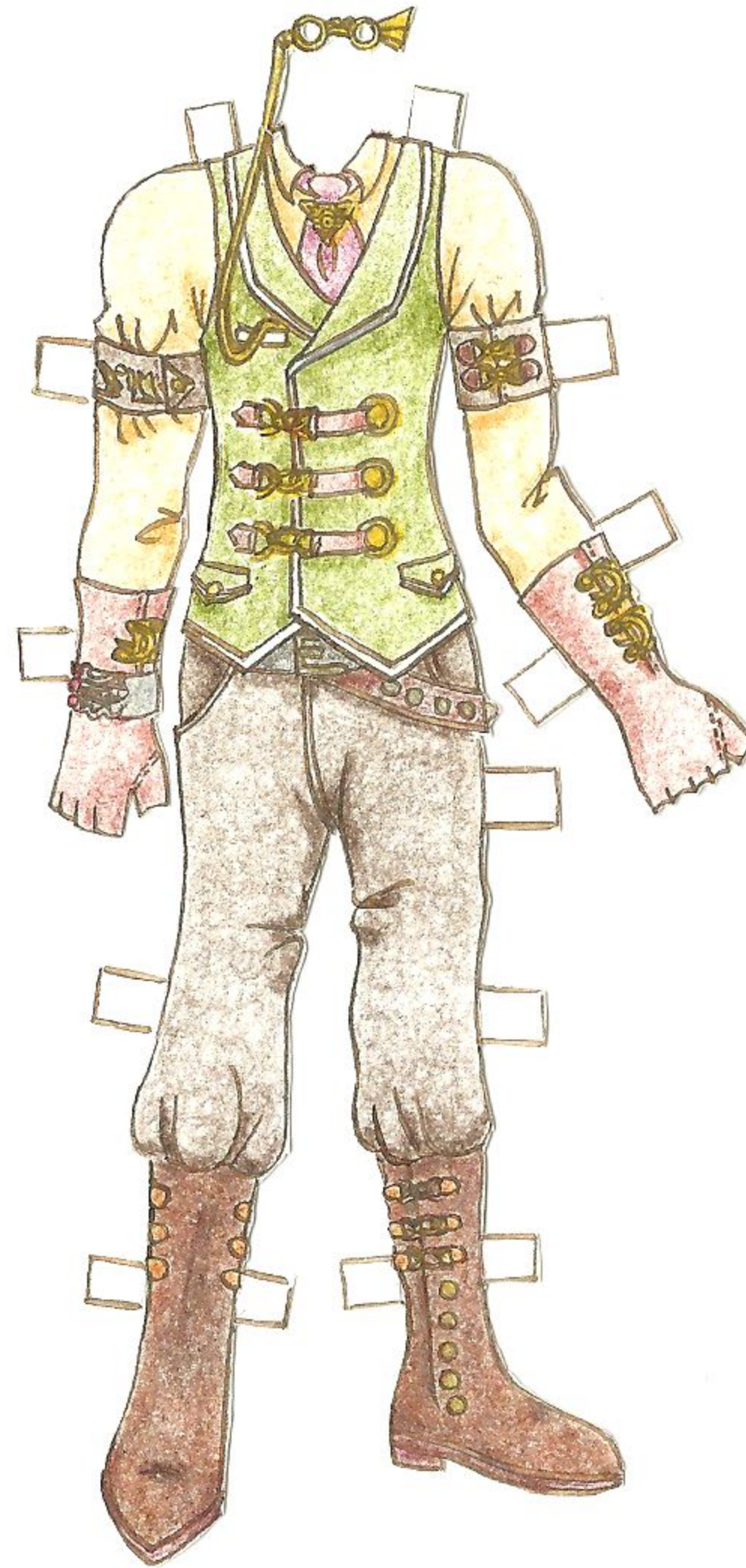


More often than not, Pharaoh Atem is spotted wearing some kind of cape! The Millennium World and Forbidden Memories outfit use the purple cape, the Battle City Flashback and Legendary Heroes outfit use the red cape.



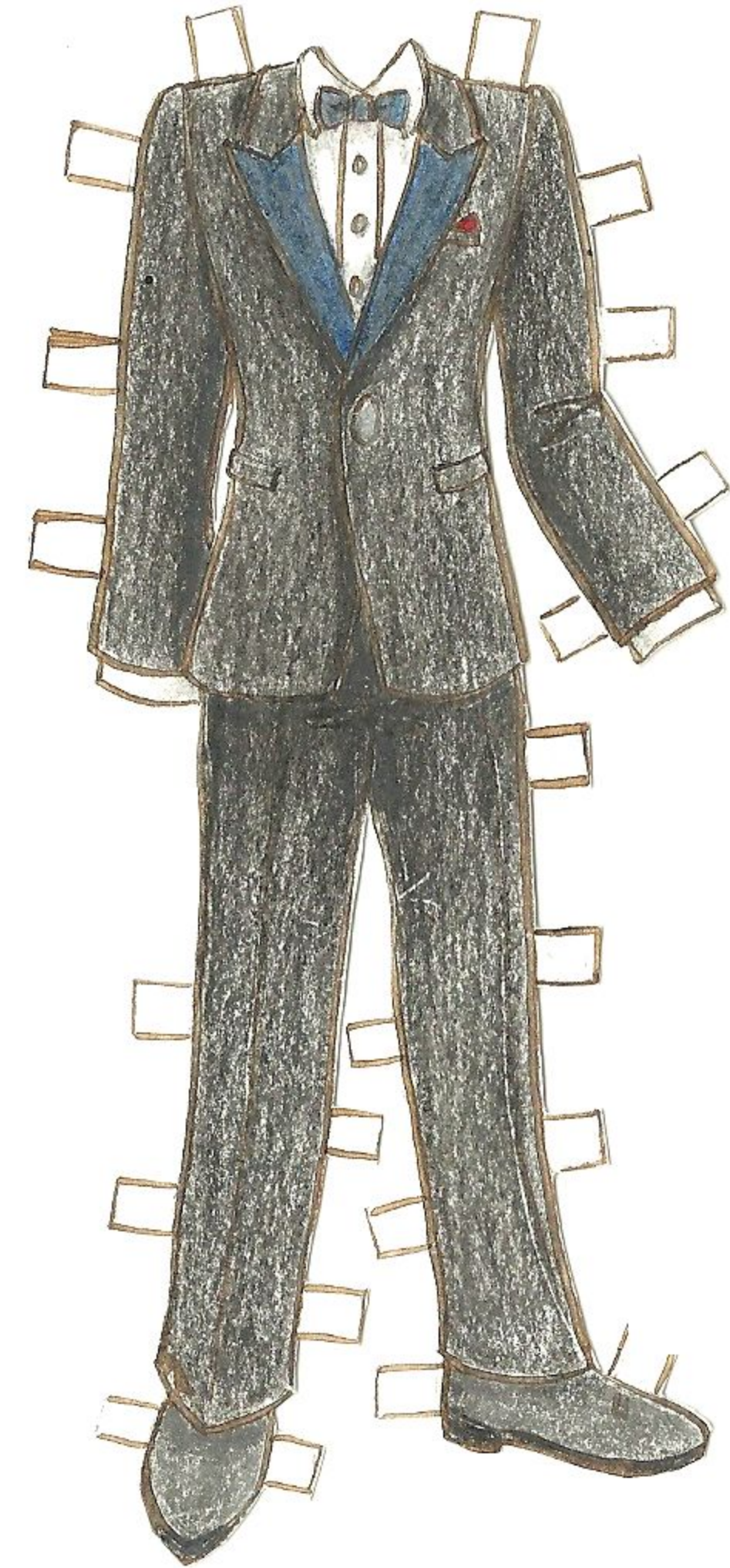
**Japanese Hakamashita:**

Perhaps it's only fitting that Atem wear a hakama with a black hakamashita featuring the Millennium Puzzle as the kamon crest.



**Steampunk Outfit:**

Based on the steampunk design done by deviantArt user FinalVirucide, this outfit gives Atem quite the dignified look.



**Formal Wear:**

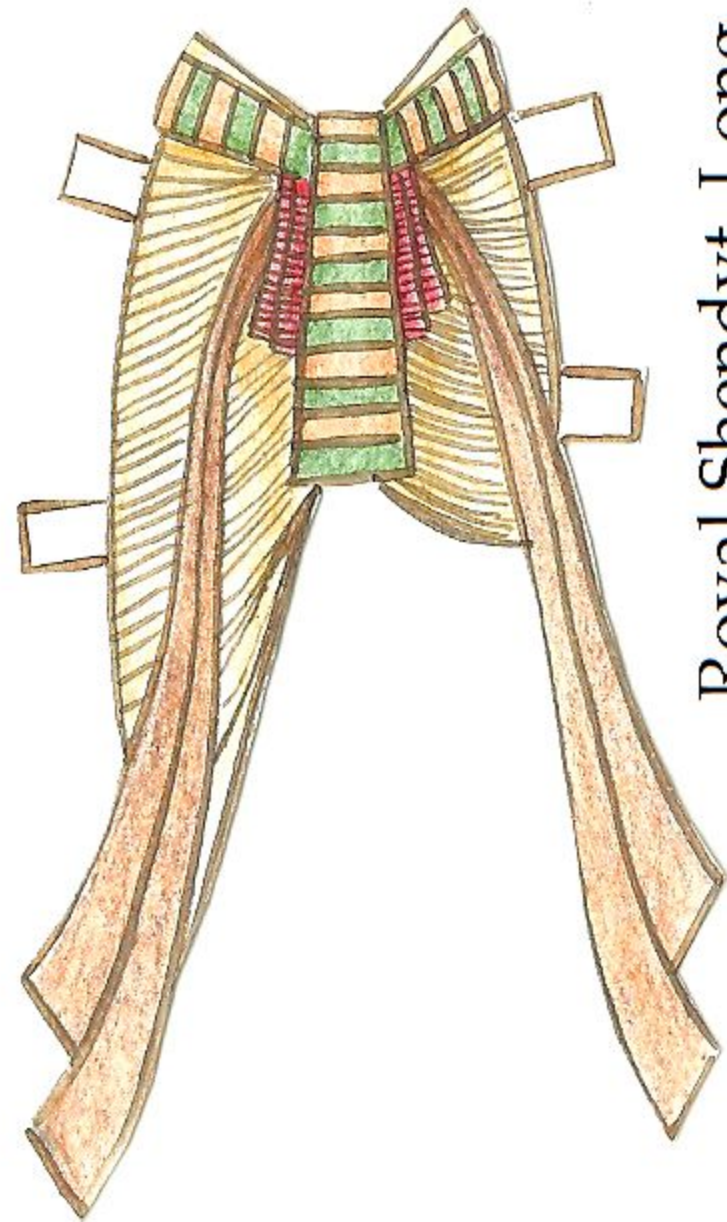

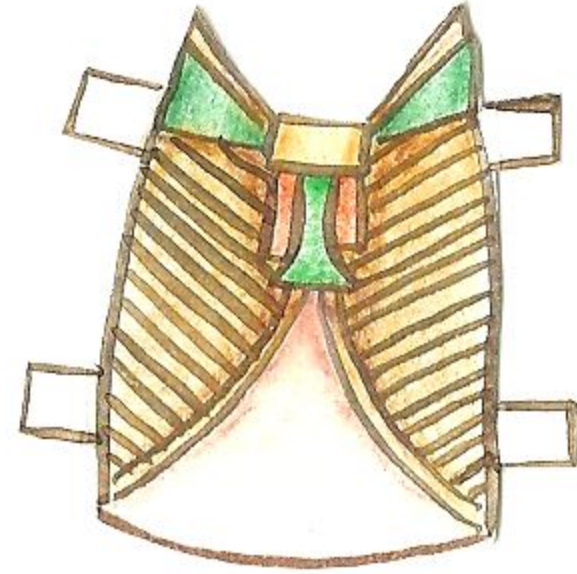

Inspired by Tumblr user homura-bakura, who suggested the idea of Atem dressed as Oberon. Design based off of Oberon costume from the Mariinsky ballet group.
